The plan outlines a structured approach to ensure effective responses, prioritizing the safety of employees and students during emergencies, whether caused by natural disasters or human-related incidents.

School Emergency Preparedness Signaling School Emergency ( <i>Ringing of</i> School Bell)	<ul> <li>First Aid Kits are stocked and ready</li> <li>"Red Folders" are updated and complete</li> <li>Drills are conducted regularly to familiarize the school with the Standard Operational Procedure (SOP) plan.</li> <li>Constantly for 1 minute for Tsunami/Earthquake</li> <li>10 times for fire or any other emergency</li> </ul>	
	SOP FOR TSUNAMI / EARTHQUAKE	
Note: Given the school's dangerous location, SOP will be activated upon ANY shaking of the ground.		
Classroom School Building	<ul> <li>"DROP, COVER &amp; HOLD ON</li> <li>Get under the desk or table and hold tight with your back to the windows</li> <li>Drop to knees; clasp both hands behind neck; bury face in arms; make the body as small as possible; close eyes and cover ears with forearms.</li> <li>Maintain position until shaking stops.</li> <li>Proceed to assembly site for headcount</li> <li>O PLAN A: Vehicles on campus will be utilized to transport students to safety.</li> <li>O VP &amp; Janitor will conduct the final sweep and proceed to the assembly site by vehicle.</li> <li>O PLAN B: (no vehicles) Proceed to the foot of the hiAdmin will lead staff and students on the roadside to the assembly site for headcount (red folders) while proceeding to the rendezvous point.</li> <li>O The final sweep is the same as PLAN A</li> </ul>	
School Grounds	<ul> <li>DROP, COVER &amp; HOLD ON</li> <li>Move quickly away from buildings, trees, overhead wires and poles</li> <li>Assume Drop and Cover position in an open space</li> <li>Maintain position until tremor stops</li> <li>See plans A &amp; B above</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Fire located on the East of campus-evacuate students West side.</li> <li>Fire located on the ocean side of campus-evacuate students to the Aoa bus stop on the West side.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Fire is located on the West side of the campus-evacuate students to the East Side.</li> <li>Notify the fire department (911).</li> <li>Keep students at a safe distance from the fire</li> <li>Take a quick roll call and report missing students (red folder)</li> <li>The fire department will determine when the school is safe for reentry.</li> </ul>	
SOP FOR INJURY / ILLNESS DURING INSTRUCTIONAL HOURS		
	<ul> <li>Refer students and or students to the office.</li> <li>Contact parents or legal guardians.</li> <li>If needed, paramedics and or proper authorities will be contacted.</li> <li>Contact ASDOE for heads-up notification.</li> <li>School personnel will accompany the injured student to the hospital.</li> <li>The administrator in charge will file a report with ASDOE.</li> </ul>	
SOP FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS		
	<ul> <li>The school administrator will physically survey the suspected site.</li> <li>Close classrooms will take evasive action upon instructions from the school administrator.</li> <li>Contact the proper authority and await further directives.</li> </ul>
