- Limited English Proficiency (LEP): Students identified from the American Samoa English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) Other: Ethnic groups aside from Asian/Pacific Islander and Samoan.
- ESSA: Every Student Succeeds Act, 2015 reauthorization of the No Child Left Behind 2001 legislation
